## National policy change – Sunscreens

We are writing to you with respect to your sunscreen, insert name of product. The conditions for which these products can now be prescribed changed on August 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. This is a national change in eligible conditions, and we are contractually obliged to follow it. The new criteria for prescribing is below

When prescribed for skin protection against ultraviolet radiation and/or visible light in abnormal cutaneous photosensitivity causing

- **severe** cutaneous reactions in genetic disorders (including xeroderma pigmentosum and porphyrias),
- severe photodermatoses (both idiopathic and acquired)
- and in those with increased risk of ultraviolet radiation causing **severe** adverse effects due to chronic disease (such as haematological malignancies), medical therapies and/or procedures.

As a result of this change in criteria, you will no longer be prescribed insert name of product. If you still require to use the sunscreen then you will need to purchase this product, or something similar yourself.
