

Stoma Miscellaneous Appliances Norfolk & Waveney Agreed Fair Usage Policy

This policy has been developed in collaboration with Clinical Nurse Specialists at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital King's Lynn, The Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital, The James Paget University Hospital and local community stoma nurses.

- New products should ONLY be initiated by Hospital/Community Stoma team.
- Retrospective & prospective requests for new items from dispensers should be declined.
- GP Practices should ensure they have written confirmation from a Hospital/Community nurse prior to issuing a prescription.
- Please ensure double quantity prescriptions are not released for holiday seasons.

Patients overusing i.e. quantities not in line with this policy will need a clinical review with the Stoma team.
